

ANSWERS:

1. The budget is \$3,000 - \$7,000 for procurement.
2. The City can amend the 15 day deployment to 45 days
3. The City currently does not have recurring fees. If recurring fees are suggested by the bidder, please list them as a separate line item. If there are differing costs for on-going contracts, such as a 3 year versus annual resigning, please list that also.
4. Due to our timeline, we can not provide an extension to the deadline.

QUESTIONS:

1. Can the City share its total and annual budget for this procurement? Providing Offerers with a clear estimate of the budget will benefit the public by allowing for the most competitive procurement process, as Offerers will compete to provide the greatest value for the City's money.
2. In order to compile a thorough and thoughtful response to the City's RFP, we respectfully request a two-week extension of the proposal deadline to September 3rd, 2020.
3. 1) In the previously released RFP Q&A (November 21, 2019), a disclosed budget was released of \$3,000-\$7,000. Is the budget the same now? If not, what is the budget for this project?

5. 2) Will the City amend the 15 day deployment timeframe to 45 days? It is unlikely that any responsible bidder will propose a system that is deployed in 15 days or less. If they do, it is unlikely they will accomplish this timeline.

7. 3) To offer the lowest implementation price, most bidders will prefer to sign a multi-year contract. Would the City of Sandy be open to a three year contract for ongoing support services? If so, how should this be accounted for on the pricing submission page (11)?
