6.2. **Update about Mural Restoration**

At the March 2019 meeting, there was a discussion about obtaining maintenance documents for the murals in the community. Before mural restoration can take place, the Commissioners recommended identifying how the murals were originally painted. This would help to identify how the murals should be restored and will have an impact on potential cost estimates.

A developing idea is to investigate how to restore and re-seal the mural on the front exterior of City Hall. This can potentially be used as a case study for restoring other murals in the community.

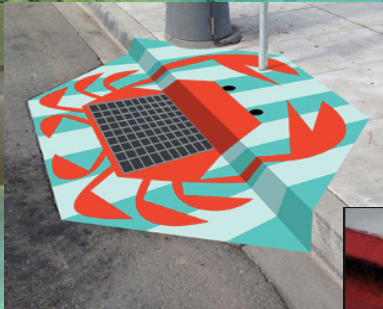
