

Attached please find information that you requested regarding the City's Neighborhood Traffic Management Program. The brochure describes the process for evaluating neighborhood traffic concerns. I have also enclosed the traffic evaluation petition form. Gathering signatures is important to demonstrate that there is broad neighborhood support for starting the process.

As you will read in the brochure, engineering solutions (speed humps, traffic circles, etc.) are only one of the possible solutions to a neighborhood traffic issue.

In addition to this program, the Police Department has a radar reader board that can be placed on your street that will let drivers know how fast they are going. You may contact the traffic officer at 503-668-5566.

Once petition form with sufficient signatures is turned in, we place our traffic counters on your street to record traffic speed and volume. The counters are in place for approximately one week, at the end of which I will send you a summary of the results and if the program thresholds are met or exceeded, describe the next steps in the process.
