IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER City of Sandy Did Not Meet Treatment Requirements

On October 29th and 30th our water system violated the drinking water standard for chlorine contact time. Although this situation did not require that you take immediate action, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

In order to ensure proper disinfection, water produced at our treatment plant must be in contact with chlorine for a minimum amount of time. Between 10:15 and 10:30 AM on October 29th, and between 3:00 and 3:45 PM on October 30th this did not occur. Although chlorine quickly kills most bacteria, it is less effective against organisms such as viruses and parasites. For this reason, water needs to mix with chlorine for a longer time period to kill such organisms. The amount of time necessary, or the contact time, depends on the amount of disinfectant in the water and the temperature of the water.

Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches.

This incident affected a small number of retail customers along Highway 26 between Waggoneer Loop Rd. and Terra Fern Drive and wholesale customers in the Section Corner and Alder Creek-Barlow water districts. In-city customers and outside-city customers west of Waggoneer Loop Dr. were not affected by this incident.

We have implemented changes in equipment and procedures at the treatment plant to prevent this from happening again.
