Do you have a cracked, heaved or unsafe sidewalk adjacent to your property? Not only is this a hazard for pedestrians it exposes you to a significant liability if someone trips or falls on the sidewalk. Sidewalk maintenance is the responsibility of the property owner but it can be nearly impossible to find a contractor to remove and replace small areas of concrete. In order to make it easier for you to replace unsafe sidewalks the City is going to package up some concrete work around Sandy and secure bids for demolition and replacement of

sidewalks and driveway approaches.

We expect to have prices for this work available after June 4th. If you are interested in taking advantage of this program please contact Thomas Fisher at 503-489-2161 or tfisher@ci.sandy.or.us to learn about the prices and arrange for the work to be done. If you have broken, cracked or heaved sidewalks but are not interested in taking advantage of this program keep in mind that Code Enforcement will still be enforcing the sidewalk maintenance provisions of the Municipal Code.
