### Conserve Water and Reduce Your Sewer Bill?

The November-December billing period is where we switch to billing you for sewage based on *actual* water consumption. This will continue until the May-June billing period when we switch back to basing your sewer bill on the *average* water consumption from the prior winter. This makes sure that outdoor water use (irrigation, car washing, etc.) during the spring, summer and fall does not get counted as sewage consumption on your bill.

With the higher water and sewer rates going into effect with the bill you receive in January, 2020 it is even more important to reduce your water consumption between November and May to help keep your sewer bill low.

In order to help you conserve water we are offering indoor water conservation kits to all customers with homes built before 1993. Homes built since 1993 are plumbed with low flow shower and faucet fixtures as well as 1.6 gallon per flush toilets.

The kits consist of a low-flow shower head (2.5 gallons per minute) and a low flow faucet aerator (1.5 gallons per minute).
