Sandy Introduces New Customer Assistance Program

The City of Sandy's utility customers will see significant rate increases on the bills they receive in January. In response, the City Council is adopting a new Customer Assistance Program to help low income households that might otherwise experience a hardship.

Starting with the utility bills customers receive this month, sewer rates will double to around \$52.35 per month for a typical household. A smaller (11%) water rate increase will also take effect, bringing the new water rate to \$25.02 for a typical utility customer using 600 cubic feet of water.

Sandy faces significant wastewater treatment challenges now and in the future. Solutions are expensive, and investments are needed now to treat that wastewater and comply with laws designed to protect our streams and rivers:

Repairing and replacing aging sewer lines and disconnecting storm drains from the sewers

Upgrading the existing treatment plant to bring it into regulatory compliance

Building a new wastewater plant that uses membrane technology to provide high quality water and meet Sandy's future needs

The City Council has approved a financial assistance program for households with an annual income below \$31,284 per year. These customers will be eligible for a 50% reduction in the sewer portion of their utility bill – keeping sewer rates about the same as today.

Customers who qualify for assistance and submit an application before February 14th will receive a credit applied to the current (January) bill. Future bills will reflect the customer assistance rate for eligible customers who have completed the application.
