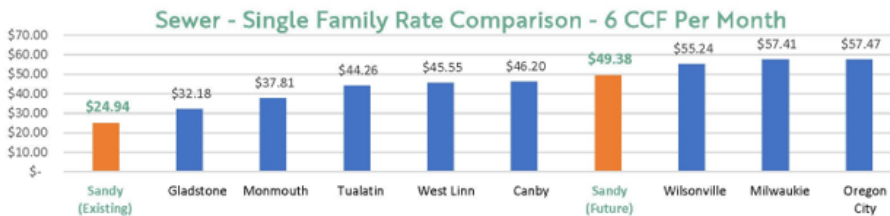
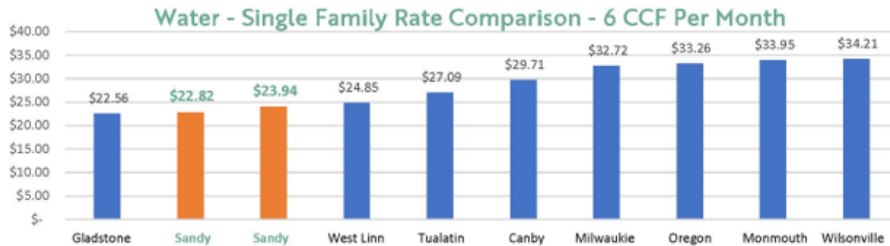
Reminder - New Rates Take Effect in 2020

Monthly Consumption (cubic feet)*	Current Rate (water and sewer)	New Rate (water and sewer)
400	\$37.52	\$60.99
500	42.70	69.18
600	47.88	77.37
700	53.06	85.56
800	58.24	93.75
900	63.42	101.94
1000	68.60	110.13

*One cubic foot of water equals 7.5 gallons

The monthly sewer bill for a typical residential customer using 600 cubic feet of water will increase about \$25.00. Water rates will increase \$1.12 per month for a typical household.

Monthly sewer and water bills for households using 600 cubic feet of water are shown below, with comparisons to nearby communities.



Fixing Sandy's wastewater problems will require significant investments. The City is working to make needed improvements as affordable as possible, including coordination with state and federal agencies to secure funding. However, customers' monthly sewer rates must rise to help support these critical investments and protect the environment. Development fees (called System Development Charges or SDCs) will also increase to ensure that new development pays its fair share.
