

ADDENDUM NO. 1
TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
CITY OF SANDY
IT/TELECOMMUNICATIONS MASTER PLAN PROPOSAL

This addendum, issued on the 3rd of March 2024, affects the request for proposal documents for the **City of Sandy IT/Telecommunications Master Plan** and shall be deemed an integral part of the above referenced document. Below are responses to recent questions from respondents.

CLARIFICATIONS AND QUESTIONS

Q: What is the budget for the creation of this Master Plan?

A: Currently, the budget is not to exceed \$50,000.

Q: Does SandyNet intend for a survey of Sandy residents or a survey of SandyNet customers to be part of identifying long-term goals/initiatives? If so, what level of support is SandyNet or the government of Sandy, OR, able to provide in this process (e.g., hosting a survey on the SandyNet website, including a request to fill out the survey in customer bills, promoting the survey via social media, list serves, and flyers)?

A: At this time, the City of Sandy has not performed any surveying of residents or current SandyNet subscribers to identify potential goals. The City of Sandy is open to utilizing a survey if it is identified to assist in providing meaningful information for the Telecommunications Master Plan. The city maintains a monthly newsletter that can seek participation from those who subscribe to City updates. The City also maintains a database of existing subscribers that may provide a sampling pool for information.

Q: Is there an option for a remote presentations and interviews?

A: Yes, Sandy City Council meetings can have remote presenters and presentations. Interviews with individuals can also be arranged around a virtual or remote meeting.
